<p><b>Research Findings</b></p> <p>Are the findings clearly presented? Appropriate use of visuals (pictures, charts, etc.)?</p>	
<p><b>Contribution and Innovation</b></p> <p>Is the final outcome of the research clearly stated? Is the contribution of the research to the field discussed? Were any innovative techniques or ideas used?</p>	
<p><b>Slide Design</b></p> <p>Not too much text, use of phrases instead of full sentences, font size not too small, appropriate contrast, font vs background, effective use of figures and pictures.</p>	
<p><b>Oral Presentation</b></p> <p>Presenter is fluent and natural, body posture, confidence, eye contact, appropriate interaction with slides (e.g. Pointing out with hand or pointer, etc).</p>
